Prevent Cyber-attacks and **ProteCT** your community

At least **170** county, city or state government systems have experienced **ransomware attacks** since **2013**-- at least **45** were police and sheriff's offices.*

➤ **Local Law Enforcement** must be contacted and will provide guidance on what to do and initiate resources to help you effectively respond to the attack.

➤ **Report Cyber Claims Immediately.** For every hour that passes thousands of dollars can be lost and millions of pieces of data can be compromised.
