

# Workers' Compensation Fraud: a high price to pay



We all pay for Workers' Compensation Fraud through higher insurance premiums, diminished workplace morale, and higher taxes—it hurts our economy and legal system overall.

Workers' Compensation Fraud is a violation of Connecticut General Statute 31-290c (2019). If the benefits obtained through fraud exceed \$2,000, the offense is a Class B felony punishable by up to 20 years in prison and up to \$10,000 in fines.
